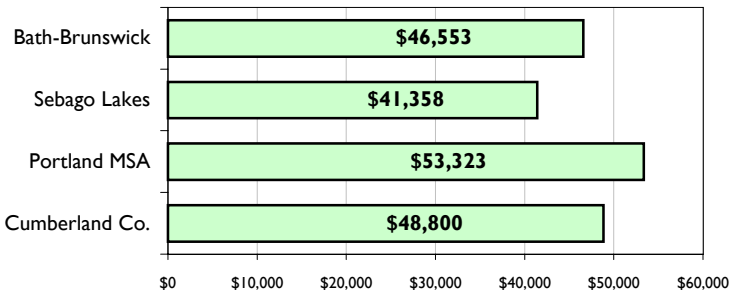

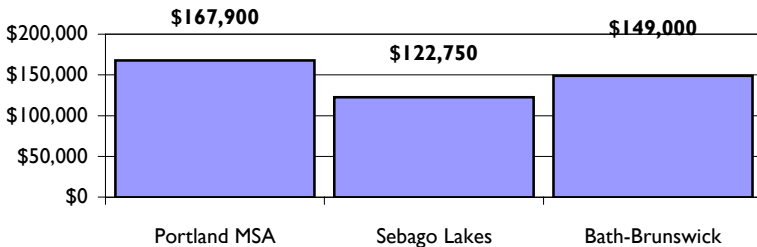

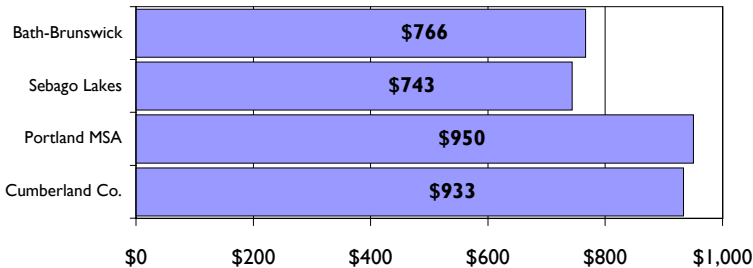

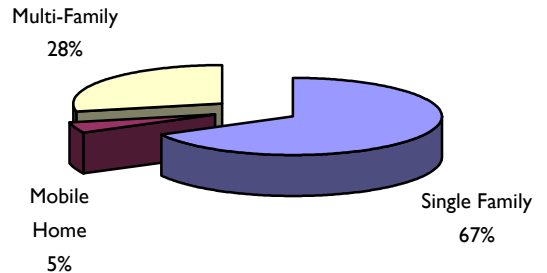
Median Home Sales Price (2002)



Average Rent for 2-BR with Utilities (2002)



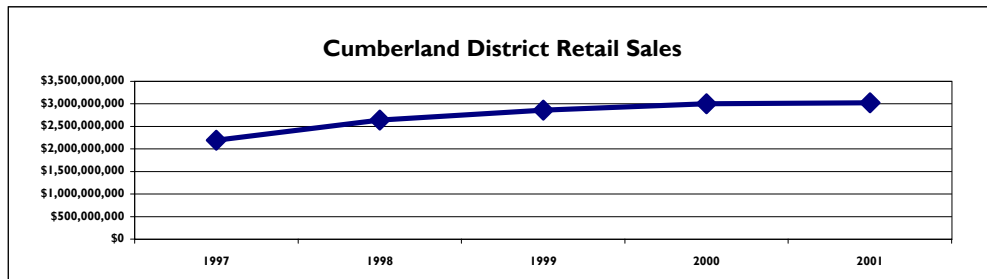
